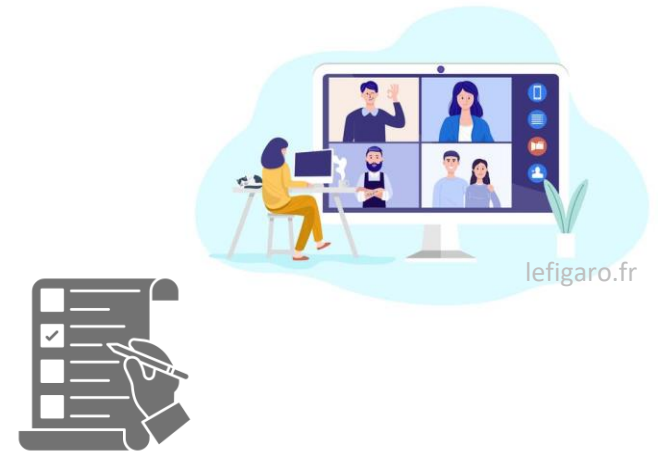
Project objectives

1. Provide a **portrait** of economic partnerships between Indigenous peoples and forest sector businesses in Quebec (QFSCI)
 - Identify the objectives and the barriers
2. Identify the investments in terms **capital** with respect to **partnership structures**



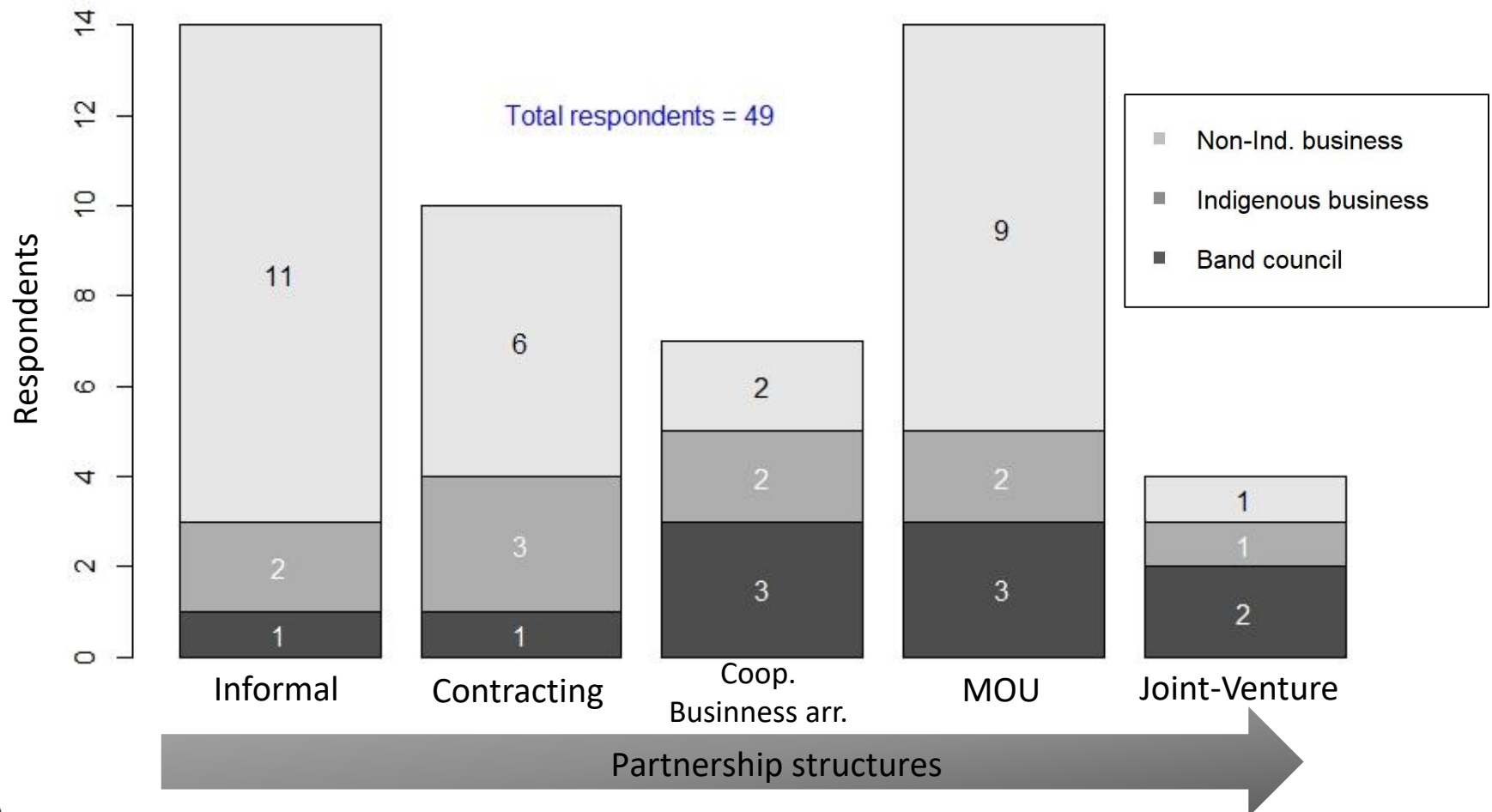
Methodology

- **Data collection: Survey**
 - Elaborated in a task force
 - Targeted respondents:
 - Forest sector businesses
 - Band councils or indigenous businesses
 - 72 respondents / 1062 emails sent
- **Interaction: partnership structures - capital investments**
 - Model selection
 - Multimodel inferences

- Ignorance and prejudices

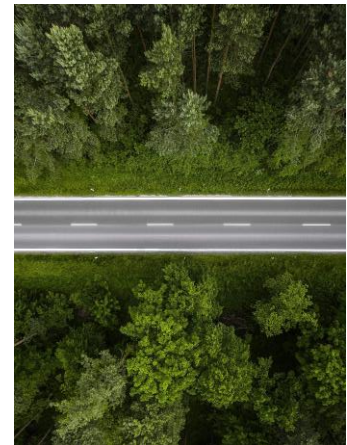
